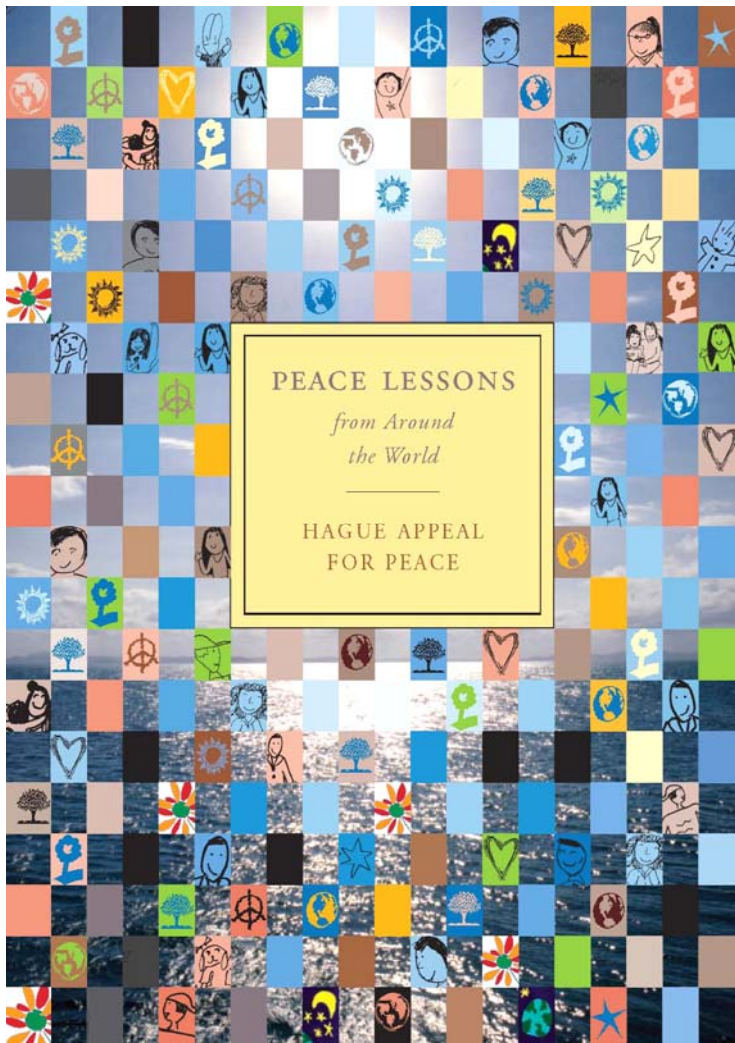


## TO REACH PEACE WE NEED TO TEACH PEACE!
